1. Welcome and review agenda

a. Committee will present to the Board on November 17

- 2. Bond update
 - a. BP01 Newton Middle School
 - i. Day 2 projects
 - 1. Working on things that need to be changed or that are missing
 - a. Installing athletic lockers that were missed in the final design, additional wainscoting, added some skate stops, and door hardware revisions
 - ii. Junior Stadium
 - 1. Abatement and demolition are complete
 - 2. Footers for bleachers are in progress
 - 3. Footers for building A and B are done, and working through the building portion of the site because you can see we have the grandstand and then the other building up by the bus road
 - 4. Will have 1000 seat capacity, and will be CHSAA approved field and track is full size, so it can hold large track meets as well as host boys and girls lacrosse, field hockey, soccer, and football
 - 5. Since abatement and demolition took an extended period of time, the stadium will not be ready for spring sports, and it is slated to be ready for fall sports 2023
 - b. BP02 Ford Elementary School
 - i. Day 2 projects
 - 1. Bus loop concrete and expanded sidewalk have begun
 - 2. Working with the city of Centennial to create a crosswalk to get the kids out of the water

- c. BP03 Gaskill Elementary School
 - i. Building opened on time, and we had a ribbon cutting ceremony on August 29
 - ii. Minor punch list items ongoing
- d. BP04 Highland Elementary School repurposing into Early Childhood Education Center
 - i. Initial demo and abatement are complete
 - ii. Modulars from Phase I have been removed
 - iii. LPS Foundation received grants to build-back playground, and that is in progress
 - iv. Construction should be completed late January early February
- e. BP05 Little Raven Elementary School
 - i. Abatement at Moody is still in progress
 - ii. The contractor Phipps has slated October 14th to get the building knocked down
 - iii. Foundation work for mechanical room in some areas is in progress
 - iv. Beam signing planned October 3rd at 3:00 p.m.
- f. BP06 EPIC
 - i. Progress is going well on the West building; structural steel, mechanical, electrical, and floor prep in progress
 - ii. East building has structural steel, slab on grade, mechanical, electrical, and plumbing rough-in
 - iii. Stormwater system and re-grading are in progress
 - iv. Building should be completed in May or June and scheduled to open fall 2023
- g. BP07 Furniture
 - i. Completed the scope for all schools
 - ii. High, middle and elementary schools have new furniture and are working on punch list items for the middle and high school furniture
- h. BP08 Transportation
 - i. No big change; radios, cameras, and fleet vehicles have been procured
