






Q.2: How big of a problem is the following issue for becoming involved with your child's current school: How busy your schedule is?


Q.3: How big of a problem is the following issue for becoming involved with your child's current school: School staff seem too busy?

Q.4: How big of a problem is the following issue for becoming involved with your child's current school: You feel unsure about how to communicate with the school?
















Q.2: How confident are you in making sure your child's school meets their learning needs?


Q.3: How confident do you feel in supporting your child's learning at home?









Q.1: How often do you help your child understand the content they are learning in school?






















Q.1: How much of a sense of belonging does your child feel at their school?




Q.3: At your child's school, how well does the overall approach to discipline work for your child?






Q.1: My child knows how to get help at school if they are worried about themselves or a friend.


Q.2: How often do you worry about violence at your child's school?


Q.3: If a student is bullied at your child's school, how difficult is it for them to get help from an adult?










